Arguing at School



*Developing the capacity of listening, expressing own views, sharing opinions, reflecting, mediating, searching solutions through dialogue is one of the key aims of education, but teachers are seldom trained to face children's conflicts and just try to repress them. The project, by comparing different approaches and testing them in four EU countries, developed a set of methodological tools and references to good practices that may be relevant for many schools across Europe. These tools and methods are means to remove violence from conflicts and use social and emotional skills to achieve new possible outcomes: the result is not only an improvement of educational practices in itself but also an improvement in people's wellbeing in day-to-day life.*
